

How to Suggest Members for HLPE Project Teams

As you are aware, the 15 member Steering Committee has already been selected. Nominations for the Roster of Experts is an on-going process. the procedure for nominating further names is available here: <http://www.fao.org/cfs/cfs-hlpe/roster-instructions/en/>

All experts who are nominated are automatically added to the Roster without any kind of vetting process and so, there is no need for the Civil Society Mechanism to be engaged in this.

The Steering Committee is in the process of identifying Project Teams, consisting of experts which the Steering Committee selects from the Roster of Experts. The Project Teams will take forward the tasks within the HLPE work program (see http://www.fao.org/cfs/cfs-hlpe/next_steps/en/) e.g. on land and agriculture investment, price volatility, social protection & climate change.

It is only the Steering Committee which selects the members of the project teams and the Civil Society Mechanism does not have a direct involvement. However, if you have suggestions as to suitable experts who could participate in Project Teams, you could first ensure that they are on the Roster of Experts and then write to the Chair of the HLPE Steering Committee via the HLPE Secretariat cfs-hlpe@fao.org
